To All Foreign EASA Part-147 Basic training organisations

Cologne, 13 September 2023

Subject: Information affecting all Foreign EASA Part-147 Basic training organisations approved by EASA.

Dear Sir, Madam,

The purpose of this letter is to inform that Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) 2023/989 was issued on 22 May 2023 and amends regulation (EU) 1321/2014. The new regulation introduces changes to Part-66 and Part-147 that are applicable from **12 June 2024**. Particularly, Article 11(2)(b) of IR 2023/989 requires that:

- all basic training courses starting after 12 June 2024 shall be compliant with IR 2023/989;
- basic training courses, or part thereof, started prior to 12 June 2024 shall be finished before 12 June 2026 including any related examinations, with corresponding Certificates of Recognition (CORs) issued using the regulation's version applicable prior to 12 June 2024.

As a consequence, Foreign EASA Part-147 basic training organisations cannot deliver basic training courses compliant with IR 2023/989 prior to 12 June 2024.¹

To allow a smooth transition to basic training courses compliant with IR 2023/989, the Foreign EASA Part-147 basic training organisations are required to provide the allocated Inspector an amended MTOE, associated procedures and Course Approval forms in compliance with IR 2023/989, **at the soonest but not later than 31 March 2024**.

Additional documents may be required by the Inspector for sampling purpose as deemed necessary (e.g. amended chapters of training material etc.).

Approval holders are required to inform the allocated Inspector (and copy EASA Maintenance Training Coordinator at MOC_147@easa.europa.eu) in case it is envisaged that basic training courses started before 12 June 2024 cannot be completed with CORs issued before 12 June 2026.

¹ A condition may occur, where organisations need to deliver basic training courses compliant with IR 2023/989 to students starting the basic training after 12 June 2024 and in parallel an older version of basic training to students who started before 2024.

In order to formalize the approval of the amended documentation, the Foreign EASA Part-147 basic training organisations will be informed of the acceptance of amended documents by the Inspector; however, the formal EASA approval of the amended documents will be finalized starting from 12 June 2024.
